Professional Tip of the Month

Pitching from Rough to Green

Players who have recently played on Jagorawi New Course would know that the rough can be quite difficult. I noticed that a lot of their techniques are inadequate to get the ball out. Some try to flop it out which in theory is a good idea but is consistently hard to do, the speed you generate is not enough and the club can twist and turn and the result can be undesirable.



Biggest key: Keep the leading arm fairly straight

Here is a simple technique that you can try the next time you are out on the course. This will definitely help you get out of that rough and onto the shorter grass.

Firstly Take a lofted club, set-up like a chip shot next thing I want you to focus on is keeping your left wrist firm through impact what this does is keep the face traveling through the grass and striking the ball.
