As many Players have not submitted caddie Evaluation Cards as requested, we are re-issuing our announcement as previously sent in 2008. Please ensure that after every round, that you request the Caddie gives you the Evaluation Card. Every Caddie on departing to the golf course has been given an Evaluation Card to submit to the Player without exception! Also please ensure that Caddies are repairing Divots, Pitch-Marks, and Rake Bunkers and pick up any rubbish on-course. Your assistance with this issue is much appreciated.

Every caddie must carry a bag of sand to repair divots! If your Caddie hasn't brought a sand-bag then please request they do so before starting your round.

Reissued Announcement from 2008:

Greetings from Jagorawi Golf & Country Club.....

To ensure that your playing experience at Jagorawi Golf & Country Club is an enjoyable one, we are taking steps to upgrade our services to you, our valued members and guests.

As of Monday, July 7th 2008 we shall incorporate a Caddie Evaluation as part of our daily operation. There is one box located in the downstairs Lobby area (under the main notice board) and another upstairs in the restaurant area (to the right at the top of the stairs)

Both these boxes are clearly marked in four categories of evaluation on your caddie's performance.

Step 1:

At arrival and on receiving your golf bag, the caddie allocated to you is given a plastic colored / numbered card (the size of a credit card) which he MUST SUBMIT TO YOU AT THE END OF THE ROUND... *please remind your caddie to hand you the card at the end of the round if he hasn't done so already*

Step 2:

At either of the 2 boxes mentioned above, simply place the card in the box which you feel best describes your caddie's performance.

These boxes shall be checked daily and each caddie shall have the result entered into their personal file. JGCC shall ensure that those caddie's who are not performing well are retrained or processed accordingly.

The caddie evaluation system is in effect daily, so please ensure a card is placed in the box after each round. The cards are color coded so if you accidentally forget to follow the system as mentioned above, you can do so the next day or hand the card to the reception reporting the date of your last round and the evaluation you intended to give.
