There will be 3 Qualifying Rounds held as follows:

Format:

Old Course / Men @ Blue Tees / Ladies @ Red Tees / **STROKEPLAY** / Tee-Off Anytime / Arrange Your Own Pairings (Minimum 3 Players per Flight) / Please Read Club Championship Rules / Submit Completed Score-Card to the Club Reception or The Starter after the game. **Please mark the card clearly as "Qualifying Round"**

ROUND: 2
Saturday, March 19th 2011

ROUND: 3
Sunday, March 20th 2011

Please Note:

Members may play in any one or all three qualifying rounds whereby the lowest score will be selected. Please read carefully the attached "Rules of Play" for both the 2011 Club Championships & the Consolation Cup.

Remember qualifying rounds are stroke-play therefore every hole must be finished out (completed with no GIMMIES or Conceded Putts etc)

Players who qualify for the championship and who loose their 1st Round matches (the 1st Round matches are played off scratch / no handicaps applied) shall automatically go through to the Consolation Cup (handicaps will apply for all matches thereafter in Consolation Cup)

The 2010 Men's & Ladies Club Champions & 2010 Order of Merit leaders (ranked 1st, 2nd & 3rd as of the final Order of Merit Rankings for 2010) are exempt from pre-qualifying in 2011.

1. **TOURNAMENT TITLE** : 2011 JGCC CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP
2. **TIME** :

Championship	: 1 st match	March 28 th	-	April 17 th	(18 holes)

	3 rd match	May 9 th	-	May 22 nd	(18 holes)

	FINAL	June 20 th	-	July 10 th	(36 Holes)
3. **VENUE** : Old Course, Jagorawi Golf & Country Club
4. **TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE** :

The Captain and Club shall act as *Championship Committee*, and is responsible for the organizing of the Championship. The Committee reserves the rights to limit the number of participants and every other aspect of the Championships. Any decision made by the Committee is final and binding.
5. **PLAYING FIELD** :

The Club Championship shall have a maximum field of 64 players (including seeded players).
Players Defeated in the First Match-play round will proceed to the Consolation Cup (Match-play on handicap)
6. **ENTRIES** :

Open to all male amateur golfers with the following qualifications:

 - JGCC member with maximum official course handicap of 24, selected through the qualifying rounds.
 - Year 2010 Club Champion and JGCC Order of Merit rank 1-3 (Latest List, Order of Merit 2010) shall be seeded to the Tournament.
 - Register name and handicap at JGCC Reception prior to the qualifying rounds.
7. **QUALIFYING ROUND** :
 - 7.1. Qualifying shall be conducted over three rounds, Old Course / Blue Tees, Sunday, March 13th / Saturday, March 19th and Sunday March 20th 2011
 - 7.2. The qualifying rounds will be played as an individual 18-hole stroke-play format.
 - 7.3. The best 60 gross scorers out of both / either events (excluding seeded players) shall qualify to join the first match.
 - 7.4. In case of a tie (ties) a count-back system shall be applied.
 - 7.5. Match-Play Rounds shall Tee-Off from the **Blue Tees (original position marked with blue stakes throughout the tournament)**.
8. **TOURNAMENT FORMAT**
 - 8.1 The Championship shall be conducted in a Single Match Play format
 - 8.2 In case of an "All Square" result at the 18th hole (36th during the final match) the match shall be decided by a "Sudden-Death" Play-off starting from Old Course Hole number 1 onwards.
 - 8.3 In the event that the Committee decides a play-off is impracticable then the match result shall be decided by the players through mutual agreement (Conceded match).
8. **ARRANGEMENT OF THE MATCH**

Participants shall arrange the date / tee-off time of the match mutually and confirm that match / date & time to the JGCC Reception. Any match played on a Weekends can only tee-off between the hours of 09:00 – 11:00. If both players cannot arrange the match within the period / dates mentioned above, then both players will be disqualified, unless either participant decides to walk out. As a matter of courtesy to other golfers we advise that all weekend matches be played as a fore-some with either another match-play match or two other mutually accepted players.
10. **RULES OF PLAY**
 - 10.1. Club Championship Match Play participants shall Tee-Off from the Blue Tee (same position as during the Qualifying Rounds, see above clause 7.6)
 - 10.2. All play shall be in accordance with the current Rules of Golf as approved by the R & A Rules Limited and with the current Local Rules approved by the Committee.
 - 10.3. In the event any round of tournament shall be rained out or cannot be held for whatever reason, the Committee shall determine what action should be taken.
 - 10.4. Discontinuance of Play and Resumption of Play shall be in accordance with article 6-8 of Rules of Golf.
 - 10.5. The Final Round of The Men's Club Championship shall be played over 36 holes.
11. **PRIZES**

The Club Championship Winner shall be awarded the Club Champion Trophy (replica) and the Club Champions Jacket. Award giving ceremony shall take place during the following Club Tournament after the final match has been played.

1. **TOURNAMENT TITLE** : 2011 JGCC LADIES CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP
2. **TIME** : Championship

3. **VENUE** : Old Course, Jagorawi Golf & Country Club
4. **TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE** :
The Ladies Club Captain and Club shall act as *Championship Committee*, and is responsible for the organizing of the Championship. The Committee reserves the rights to limit the number of participants and every other aspect of the Championships. Any decision made by the Committee is final and binding.
5. **PLAYING FIELD** :
The Club Championship shall have a maximum field of 32 players (including seeded players)
Players Defeated in the First Match-play round will proceed to the Consolation Cup (Match-play on handicap)
6. **ENTRIES** :
Open to all Female amateur golfers with the following qualifications:
 - JGCC member with maximum official course handicap of 28 and selected through any of the 3 qualifying rounds.
 - Year 2010 Club Champion and JGCC Order of Merit rank 1-3 (Latest List, Order of Merit 2010) shall be seeded to the Tournament
 - Register name and handicap at JGCC Reception prior to the qualifying rounds.
7. **QUALIFYING ROUND** :
 - 7.1. Qualifying shall be conducted over three rounds, Old Course / Blue Tees, Sunday, March 13th / Saturday, March 19th and Sunday March 20th 2011
 - 7.2. The qualifying rounds will be played as an individual 18-hole stroke-play format.
 - 7.3. The best 28 gross scorers out of both events (excluding seeded players) shall qualify to join the first match.
 - 7.4. In case of a tie (ties) a count-back system shall be applied.
 - 7.5. Participants (Qualifying & Match-Play Rounds) shall play from the Ladies **Red Tees. (original position marked with red stakes throughout the tournament)**
8. **TOURNAMENT FORMAT**
 - 8.1. The Championship shall be conducted in a Single Match Play format
 - 8.2. In case of “all square” at the 18th Hole (36th Hole in Final match) the match shall be decided by a “Sudden-Death” Play-off starting from Old Course Hole number 1 onwards.
 - 8.3. In the event that the Committee decides a play-off is impracticable then ties shall be decided by the players through mutual agreement (Conceded match)
9. **ARRANGEMENT OF THE MATCH**
Participants shall arrange the date / tee-off time of the match mutually and confirm that match / date & time to the JGCC Reception. Any match played on a Weekends can only tee-off between the hours of 09:00 – 11:00. If both players cannot arrange the match within the period / dates mentioned above, then both players will be disqualified, unless either participant decides to walk out. As a matter of courtesy to other golfers we advise that all weekend matches be played as a fore-some with either another match-play match or two other mutually accepted players.

THE 2011 MEN'S CONSOLATION CUP RULES

1. **TOURNAMENT TITLE** : 2011 JGCC CONSOLATION CUP (Match Play on Handicap)

2. **TIME** : Championship : 1st match April 18th – May 8th (18 holes)
2nd match May 9th – May 22nd (18 holes)
3rd match May 23rd – June 5th (18 holes)
4th match June 6th - June 19th (18 holes)
FINAL June 20th - July 10th **(18 Holes)**

3. **VENUE** : Old Course Jagorawi Golf & Country Club

4. **TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE** :

The Captain and Club shall act as *Tournament Committee*, and is responsible for organizing the Championship. The Committee reserves the right to limit the number of participants and every other aspect of the Championships. Any decision made by the Committee is final and binding.

5. **PLAYING FIELD** :

The Consolation Cup shall have a maximum field of 32 players (No seeded Players)

Consolation Cup players are those players “knocked out” during match-play round 1 of the Men’s Club Championships

6. **ENTRIES** :

Open to all male amateur golfers with the following qualifications:

- JGCC member with maximum official course handicap of 24, selected through the qualifying rounds.
- Register name and handicap at JGCC Reception prior to the qualifying rounds.

7. **QUALIFYING ROUND** :

7.1. Only those who competed in any of the 3 Club Championship Qualifying rounds and qualified amongst the top 64 players (including seeded players) for the Men’s Club Championship are eligible.

7.2. The qualifying round will be played as an individual 18-hole stroke-play format.

7.3. The Consolation Cup field is made up of those players who lost their 1st round match-play match during round 1 of the Men’s Club Championships.

7.4. Match-Play Rounds shall Tee-Off from the **Blue Tees (original position marked with blue stakes throughout the tournament)**.

8. **TOURNAMENT FORMAT**

8.1. The tournament shall be conducted in a **Single Match Play format on handicap (February 2011 handicap index shall be applied throughout the tournament)**

8.2. The higher handicap player receives the full difference between the Course Handicaps of the two players; the lower handicapped player shall play from scratch (e.g. A player with a Course handicap of 17 shall receive four strokes from a player with a Course handicap of 13. He receives them on the holes allocated as the first four handicap-stroke holes.)

8.3. In case of an “All Square” result at the 18th Hole that match shall be decided by “Sudden-Death” Play-off starting from Old Course Hole number 1 onwards.

8.4. In the event that the Committee decides a play-off is impracticable then the match result shall be decided by the players through mutual agreement (Conceded match).

9. **ARRANGEMENT OF THE MATCH**

Participants shall arrange the date / tee-off time of the match mutually and confirm that match / date & time to the JGCC Reception. Any match played on a Weekends can only tee-off between the hours of 09:00 – 11:00. 1. **TOURNAMENT TITLE** : 2011 JGCC LADIES CONSOLATION CUP (Match Play on Handicap)
2. **TIME** : Championship : 1st match April 18th – May 8th (18 holes)
2nd match May 9th – May 22nd (18 holes)
3rd match May 23rd – June 5th (18 holes)
FINAL June 6th - July 19th **(18 Holes)**

3. **VENUE** : Old Course Jagorawi Golf & Country Club

4. **TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE** :

The Ladies Captain and Club shall act as *Tournament Committee*, and is responsible for organizing the Championship. The Committee reserves the right to limit the number of participants and every other aspect of the Championships. Any decision made by the Committee is final and binding.

5. **PLAYING FIELD** :

The Consolation Cup shall have a maximum field of 16 players (No seeded players)

Consolation Cup players are those players “knocked out” during match-play round 1 of the Ladies Club Championships

6. **ENTRIES** :

Open to all female amateur golfers with the following qualifications:

- JGCC member with maximum official course handicap of 28, selected through the qualifying rounds.
- Register name and handicap at JGCC Reception prior to the qualifying rounds.

7. **QUALIFYING ROUND** :

- 7.1. Only those who compete in any of the 3 Club Championship Qualifying rounds and qualified amongst the top 32 players (including seeded players) for the Ladies Club Championship are eligible.
- 7.2. The qualifying round will be played as an individual 18-hole stroke-play format.
- 7.3. The Consolation Cup field is made up of those players who lost their 1st round match-play match during round 1 of the Ladies Club Championships.
- 7.4. Participants (Qualifying & Match-Play Rounds) shall tee off from the **Red Tees (original position marked with red stakes throughout the tournament)**

8. **TOURNAMENT FORMAT**

- 8.1. The tournament shall be conducted in a **Single Match Play format on handicap (February 2011 handicap index shall be applied throughout the tournament).**
- 8.2. The higher handicap player receives the full difference between the Course Handicaps of the two players; the lower handicapped player shall play from scratch (e.g. A player with a Course handicap of 17 shall receive four strokes from a player with a Course handicap of 13. She receives them on the holes allocated as the first four handicap-stroke holes.)
- 8.3. In case of an “All Square” result at the 18th Hole that match shall be decided by “Sudden-Death” Play-off starting from Old Course Hole number 1 onwards.
- 8.4. In the event that the Committee decides a play-off is impracticable then the match result shall be decided by the players through mutual agreement (Conceded match).
