Kampung Kids (www.kampungkids.org)

Expanded programs to 8 R.T's of Kampung (with around 50-65 families each)

- Sponsored 50 students (July '07 - June '08) (40 Elementary Students, 5 Junior High - School students & 5 Senior High School students)
- Set up an Elderly Program for 8 new Kampung
- Set up a Clinic for children under 5.

Family Care (www.fcindo.com)

- A yearly social program to promote a cross-cultural, cross-religious theme between local social foundations. In this second event there were 500 orphans invited from 9 institutions
- School renovation on a small island just off the coast of Jakarta called Pulau Sembilangan, initiated basic food program to the people who are mostly fishermen
- Scholarship Program: continued to support a total of 130 children thru school sponsorship program
- Flood Relief Program: in the month of February at the outbreak flood in Jakarta volunteer workers were able to provide quick assistance to the many areas affected by the flood. Medical assistance, basic food distribution and other daily basic necessities
- Financial Assistance to assist a young girl (Nabila) who was burnt badly who remains in Fatmawati Hospital receiving treatment.

Many children are born with birth defects in Indonesia. Some require Cranial Facial Reconstructive surgery. Many families cannot afford these operations and therefore these children live with their hands permanently in front of their faces hiding their facial features.
